I learn through repetition and I have lots of opportunities revisit learning and embed it through a range of activities, with different people and in a range of contexts.

How adults support my learning

My adults work closely with me to build relationships which help me to feel safe and confident. My adults know which schemas I am using at the moment and how these can be used to extend my learning. I am supported to develop my independence and enabled to make choices and requests using a range of communication methods and by my adults acting as my advocate.
