

Maths - Shape, Space and Measure.

Shape, space and measure: For the shape, space and measure activities there are two levels of provision: explorers and investigators. Please choose the activity that you think best suits your child's needs.

Explorers.

Sorting activities: try sorting objects you have at home into different categories such as colours, sizes and shapes.



Time: Try looking at and talking about different times of the day and the different things we do at these different times, for example, going to bed at night time etc. Try using the words 'first' 'next' 'last'

Investigators

Looking at patterns and sequencing

Can you make patterns with things you have at home. Lego or duplo can be good for this, start with a 2 colour pattern and see if the children can copy and continue it. You could then try using more colours and objects and making the patterns more complicated. Twinkl is good for ideas and has some free resources to print.

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Time

Try talking about the time and what time it is, try looking when it is an o'clock and talking about where the big and little hands are. If this goes ok move on to half past and so on.

You could try making your own clock - there are more ideas on google and youtube.



Days of the week

Try talking about the different days of the week, see if the children can remember the order.

The hungry caterpillar story is a nice way of doing this.

There are some days of the week songs on you tube.

Try talking about yesterday and tomorrow.

You could try making a diary or journal with pictures or some writing about each day.
